

# Humpday Farmers' Market 2023 Season

Greetings from The Humpday Farmers Market (HDFM)!

We appreciate your interest in our Wednesday marketplace. To participate as a vendor, you must apply to sell at the HDFM and be approved. HDFM is a producer only market, meaning that you must grow it, make it, or bake (cook) it to sell at the market. You need to return the completed vendor agreement by March 1<sup>st</sup> – we will make decisions shortly after that and you will be notified by Friday, March 10<sup>th</sup>. Also send a text to Margie Sawicki at 618-407-8033 as soon as possible to let us know that you are sending an application. We will be recruiting other vendors so that we can assure a full market.

Applying does not guarantee you a space at the market. All vendor applications are reviewed and carefully considered. After review, applicants will be notified by phone or e-mail of the status of their application within two weeks. All accepted vendors will be asked to provide a short bio about their farm and pictures or a short video showcasing unique elements of their farm. Please review the provided check list as incomplete applications will not be considered.

Market hours are Wednesdays from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m., April 5<sup>th</sup> thru October 25th. This market, as all farmers market, is a rain or shine market, hot or cold. The market will be in the parking lot of Legacy Fitness at 2421 West Main Street, Carbondale. Set-up for market begins at 1:30 p.m. Take down must be completed by 7:00 p.m. No retail sales are allowed prior to the start of the market. Vendors are not allowed to leave market early, unless previously approved by the market manager.

**Weather:** The market manager will discuss the safety situation of questionable weather with the market board and contact vendors if there is a cancelation of market. Often when there is heavy rain or lightning, we retreat to the vehicles until the threat subsides. Customers count on consistent market presence for all farmers markets.

**By Law:** you are required to report your own sales and remit the sales taxes on those sales to the Illinois Department of Revenue. Raw foods are taxed at 1% and processed and non-food goods are taxed currently at 8.75%.

**Additionally**, all vendors must submit proof of Liability Insurance upon approval of application. Thank you again for your interest in The Humpday Farmers' Market, and we look forward to receiving your application. Cottage Food Operations will be expected to comply with the new regulations for "Home to Market Act" and register with your local health department. You must register with your county Department of Health – they will issue a Certificate of Registration with a Registration Number. This registration number will be required on your product labels.
What products have you been approved by your county health department?
Since Humpday Farmers' Market takes place in Jackson County, you should make a courtesy call to let them know you are at the market. Always have your certificates with you, because the Health Department will make at least one inspection visit at the market during the season.

If yes, then you must apply for a IDPH Farmers Market Food Product Sampling Handler Certificate and have it on hand at the market. If you have an Illinois Food Service Sanitation Manager Certificate, then the fee is \$10, and you must comply with the rules of IDPH for keeping food safe for consumption.

## NON-FOOD, ARTISAN, CRAFT VENDORS - CREATIVE PROCESS

#### **VENDOR RATES**

The market has two vendor categories:

- 1) <u>seasonal vendor</u> all 30 market weeks. Rental fees are prepaid in 1 or 2 installments. No refunds for missed market days but you receive a discount for paying up front for the whole season.
- 2) <u>daily vendor</u> selling on 1-30 market weeks but rental fees are paid weekly on the day of market.

#### Seasonal Vendor: The seasonal vendor rental fee for 30 markets is \$260, rather than \$300.

- Seasonal vendors commit to attending every market of the season, receive location assignment and can choose to be in the same location each market week.
- This requires early payment for the market season paid in full on the 1<sup>st</sup> market day, 4/5/23.
- The seasonal vendor does not need to notify the HDFM President of their intent to participate each week. <u>However</u>, they must notify the HDFM President as soon as possible <u>if they will miss a market</u>. No refunds for missed market days.
- Seasonal vendors are featured on the HDFM website, social media postings and marketing material including press releases.

<u>NOTE</u>: Seasonal Vendors may also arrange to make 2 payments of \$130 on 4/5/23 and 7/5/23. If this causes a hardship, then speak with the HDFM President, Angela Batson at 618-713-1282.

#### **Daily Vendor**: The Daily vendor rate is \$10/day paid on the day of market.

- Daily vendors must contact the HDFM President by 2pm on Monday prior to the Wednesday Market.
- Daily vendors can be featured in the HDFM website if they plan to attend at least half of the market days.
- Daily vendors will be included in the social media postings, if information is provided via text to Margie Sawicki by Monday evening prior to market.
